- **New 10-foot shared-use path on the east side** for safer walking and biking.
- **Roadway widening and a raised median** to improve safety and traffic flow.
- **Extended turn lanes at Sabal Lakes Road** to help reduce congestion.
- **New high-visibility crosswalks** to improve pedestrian safety and driver awareness.

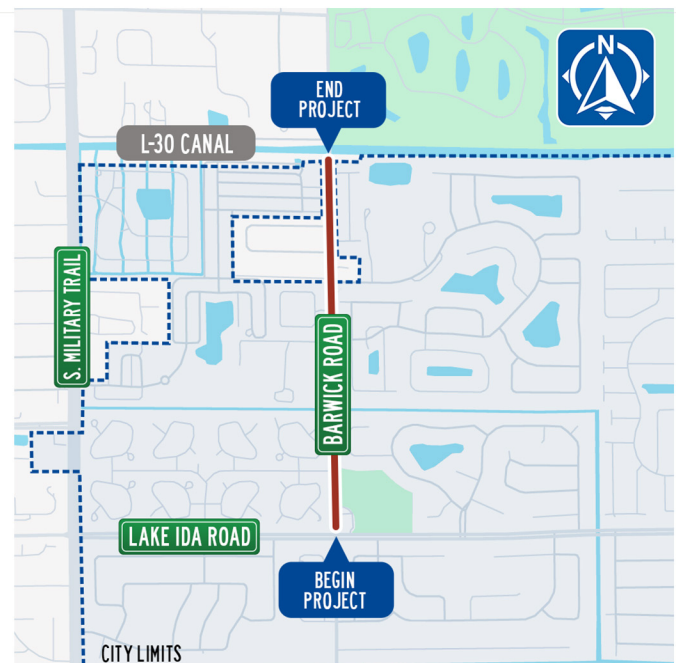
